2 Matters Arising

Approval for the Minutes of the Meetings of July 2018 were proposed by Nigel Packer and Seconded by Tony Robson.

3 Group Chairman's Report

In the matter of the complaint that had been received from one of the Group Members via IAM RoadSmart there has been no substantial development since the meeting that took place between the Complainant, Paul and Nigel in early May.

A conference call involving Amanda Smith and Robbie Downing from IAM RoadSmart, Jonathan and the Complainant had been scheduled for 13th August 2018 by Robbie Downing following a lengthy discussion between Robbie and Jonathan at the end of July. An update will be provided following that call. (On 9th August 2018 an e-mail was sent to Jonathan by Robbie Downing advising that this conference call had been cancelled further extending the resolution).

3.1

During April and May concerns were raised about the responses that various Group Members had received from Surety regarding their insurance renewal quotations. The consensus was that the feedback and communication process with Surety was not as good as it could be or perhaps should be. Paul has spoken with Robbie Downing but received the standard responses regarding their trying to price match.

It was anticipated that this matter would be discussed at this Committee Meeting however time was limited so it was again carried forward to the September Meeting to determine next actions to be taken.

15 Date of Next Meeting


The next meeting is scheduled for 4th September 2018 at the Holiday Inn, Gorsebrook Road to start at 19:45.



Who Saw Us and Followed Us


Aggregated demographic data about the people who like your Page based on the age and gender information they provide in their user profiles.


