The Minutes of this Meeting as reported here have been moderated and amended to reflect additional input following a meeting that took place on 20th September between Pat Doughty and Amanda Smith of IAM RoadSmart and Paul Williamson and Jonathan Hughes of WAM.

Paul commenced by welcoming and thanking all attendees.

2 Matters Arising

Approval for the Minutes of the Meetings of July 2018 were proposed by Tony Robson and Seconded by Roy Richards.

3 Group Chairman's Report

In the matter of the complaint that had been received from a Group Member via IAM RoadSmart; following a meeting that took place on 20th September 2018 involving Paul Williamson, Jonathan Hughes, Pat Doughty and Amanda Smith the matter has now been resolved.

3.1

During April and May concerns were raised about the responses that various Group Members had received from Surety regarding their insurance renewal quotations. The consensus was that the feedback and communication process with Surety was not as good as it could be or perhaps should be.

Following discussions with IAM RoadSmart it is understood that Pat Doughty, (Director or Operations for IAM RoadSmart), will be attending meetings in Northern Ireland with the senior management of Surety and will be raising this issue with them. We believe from feedback received that experiences within Wolverhampton Advanced Motorists are not isolated.

Details continue to reflect well on Wolverhampton Group. It is however of concern that our allocation of new Associates is now dropping well below the Regional averages.

4.1

Following discussion, it was seen appropriate that as a memento of the Groups fortieth anniversary be produced for all Group Members. The decision was made that, subject to acceptable pricing, that an RFID Blocker Card be produced as this would give opportunity for promotion of the Group as well as being an item of use for the Members.

Artwork has now been agreed for the provision of an RFID Card and pricing is to be obtained for the card.

4.2

During the discussion between Jonathan Hughes and Amanda Smith it was understood that the updated Group Handbook would be issued towards the end of October 2018.

Amanda advised that inputs from Groups regarding the content of the Handbook had been taken into consideration and that there was now a section relating to GDPR.

4.3

During the discussion between Jonathan Hughes and Amanda Smith it was understood that IAM RoadSmart had made the decision that there would be no National Conference in 2019 as the last Conference, held in 2016, had been both costly and more importantly, had failed to communicate to the right people within the Groups. (This apparently with the exception of those Groups within Region 4 where attendance and forwarding of information from the Conference was virtually 100%).

4.4

The matter of Group Event Insurance was discussed with Amanda Smith and Pat Doughty. It was understood that the majority of "small" events could be run without any additional insurance cover being put into place. A "template" for the management of these events has been designed and will be made available within the next few weeks.

5 Group Treasurers' Report

Geoff presented the Group accounts.

The Group Accounts remain in good order.

5.1

It should be noted that at this time the Group holds two Current Accounts pending the closure of the "old" account and the transfer of the funds within that account to the new Treasurers Current Account.

5.2

Now that the Treasurers Account is open with Lloyds Bank the signatories on that account need to be clarified as being the Chair, Treasurer and Secretary of the Group.

5.3

The facility to manage the Group Current Account using on-line banking is to be established as soon as possible.

5.4

The Group Accounts for the period to May 2018 have yet to be audited. Paul has agreed to pick this up and have the accounts audited by a Chartered Accountant contact that he is aware of. It was agreed that this should be completed as soon as possible.

5.5

A letter of thanks is to be generated and sent to Beryl Goold regarding her recent generous donation to the Group.

6 Group GDPR Compliance Officers Report

Group GDPR compliance remains intact. The Treasurer computer facility is to be secured to meet IAM RoadSmart and Group expectations.

6.1

There now remains only one Observer who has to sign the Group Compliance document.

6.2

GDPR is now to feature as a control section within the forthcoming update of the IAM RoadSmart Group Management Handbook that is due for issue at the end of October 2018.

7 **Group Chief Observer Report**

- A pre-test drive was undertaken with Sheila Barnfather and she was put forward for test.
- Assessment Drives were scheduled for Tony Robson, Nigel Packer, Graham Foulkes and Geoff Davis prior to their re-validating their ADT.

7.1

The next Observers Evening is scheduled for 16th October 2018. The focus of this evening is to be Spoken Thought.

8 Group Associate Controller's Report

9.1

It was suggested that we should make e-mail contact with local IAM RoadSmart Members who are not currently affiliated with a Group and "encourage" Group association so as to enhance their return on their membership.

10 Group Newsletter Editors' Report

The closing date for the Autumn Newsletter was 1st July. Tony pressed for submissions from the Group Chair to complete the Newsletter.

11 Group Web Administrators Report

Jonathan reported activity on Facebook and within our Group Twitter Accounts had improved a little compared to July. Full details are available in Appendix 1 to these Minutes.

11.1

During the course of August our web-site was hacked despite the in-place security and a massive DoS attack was launched ostensibly against our site host HostPapa. This was resolved within a matter of hours of it becoming known and new security put in place by way of end to end encryption and a shift of the server DNS address.

11.2

Following discussion, it was agreed that a Bulletin Board, (Forum), should be implemented to further engage the Observers within Group activities. It would be necessary for this BB to be secure which is placing complications on its implementation.

11.3

It was discussed and thought wise to enhance the web site by adding links through to additional HMSO Materials such as The Highway Code. Consideration as to how to do this will be given by Jonathan prior to the next Committee Meeting.

11.4

It was agreed that we should update and renew the Quiz that's on the Group web site.

12 Group Publicity and Events Co-ordinator's Report

Group presence at the Himley Classic Car Show was cancelled at the last minute as a result of substantial lack of support despite efforts to gain additional persons to man the stand. This was felt to be a great shame as the show has always been busy for the Group in the past.

12.1

The Treasure Hunt that took place on 9th September, managed by Nigel Packer, was a great success and featured in an entry in the IAM RoadSmart "Inform" e-mag that is circulated to all Groups across the Country.

12.2

Following the success of our Paddy Hopkirk evening it was considered worthwhile our seeing if we could get Nigel Mansell to a future event, however following discussions with Pat Doughty of IAM RoadSmart on 20th September it was understood that it would not be possible for us to make any arrangements in this as Nigel spends so little time within the UK. Alternatives were put forward by Pat which are to be followed up by Jonathan as they are clarified. (Two options which are available to us are {at Doughty himself and Richard Gladman, (Head of Standards at IAM RoadSmart both of whom have indicated their willingness to come to an event organised by us).

12.3

Chris raised the possibility of getting the Group coverage on local radio stations. This was agreed as being a positive thought and it was recommended that Chris liaise with Paul to gain insight into previous activities in this direction.

12.4

We have been advised that The Holiday Inn wished to raise the cost of our room hire, (we have been using these facilities for Committee, Observer and Associate Meetings for some time). As a result of this facilities have now been found at a reasonable rate at The Goldthorn Mercure Hotel on the Penn Road. Meetings scheduled from October 2018 onward are to be held at this location.

Jonathan is to contact all Observers, Associates and Committee Members to ensure they are aware of the change to venue. This is to be reflected on the web-site as soon as possible.

12.5

We have been contacted by IAM RoadSmart with regard to places available at the Continental Tyres Driving Event being organized for non-members. This detail is to be taken and circulated to all Group Members.

12.6

Roy Richards raised the question of availability of Wolverhampton Advanced Motorists "Customised Bags" for Observers and other active staff. It is understood that there are no further bags available from the stock that was purchased towards the end of 2016.

Costs and minimum order quantities of printed and unprinted bags are to be found from IAM RoadSmart with a view that, if the minimum order quantity of printed bags is too great for our needs then we should purchase unprinted and get local printing done.

12.7

Nigel Packer raised the possibility of a "Tea-Time" visit to the Wolverhampton Blind Institute. These visits are available at the end of both November and the first week in December at a cost of £10.95 or £12.95 if a glass of Prosecco was required.

Nigel advised that he did not have time to manage this and as such left it to the Committee should the proposal be considered worth following.

13 Group Young Driver Ambassador Report.

No input was received from David for this Meeting.

14 A.O.B.

Following discussion, it was felt that the Regional Observer Training Event that was being arranged by Redditch Advanced Motorists would not be supported by Wolverhampton Advanced Motorist.

15 Date of Next Meeting

The next meeting is scheduled for 2nd October 2018 at the Business Centre of the Goldthorn Mercure Hotel, Penn Road to start at 19:45.





Aggregated demographic data about the people who like your Page based on the age and gender information they provide in their user profiles.




